Meeting called to order: 7:30 pm.

Guest: Dan Daley.

President Barrett: No report...had been scheduled to be out of town on business.

Guest Speaker: Dan Daley reported on his experience at the USA Hockey ADM Symposium. Has handouts available. Emphasized the positive reactions to “cross-ice,” and the talks given by Brian Burke, Igor Larionov, among others. Skill development versus “system” development.

Treasurer Rosales: Will be online soon. Some Locals need to pay for their background checks. There will be a small increase in fees next year, to allow for a “rainy day” surplus...at the suggestion of USA Hockey. This fund will be created over a few years, to keep the increases reasonable.

GTG Director Cioffi: Absent due to coaching commitment. Has received no proposals to use the grant money from USA Hockey.

Coaching Director: Dan Daley reporting for Craig. Clinics are finished. There will be changes to the Coaching Credential Program. Level 1&2 will be valid for only 1 year. Level 3 for 2 years. Will be required to take “age appropriate” module EACH year. Other changes coming.

VP Cabanaw: State Tournament draws were completed. Next season, will use a “bingo” type system to complete the draw.
